CINCH® Jeans has continually supported the CSU Equine Sciences program and the annual Legends of Ranching Performance Horse Sale. Once again, they have graciously given \$10,000 in scholarship money to be awarded to students who have actively participated in the current year Legends of Ranching Performance Horse Sale.

Eligibility:

Students must be currently enrolled in ANEQ 359 – Equine Sales Management II or ANEQ 341 – Horse Training & Sales Prep II and have a minimum CSU cumulative GPA of 2.75 to be eligible to apply for this scholarship. **Note:** *Teaching Assistants in either class are not eligible to apply even if they are taking the course for credit.*

Application Process:

- A hard copy of the completed application with resume must be submitted to Morgan Offutt no later than **12 pm, Wednesday March 25th, 2020**.
- All applicants are required to participate in an interview. Interviews will be held **Wednesday, April 1st** in the ETRC Conference Room.
- You will sign-up for your interview time slot in LOR Recitation. This is on a first come, first serve basis. Students should dress business formal for the interview as representatives from Cinch will be conducting the interview. Dress to impress!
- Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Consignor Mix ‘N Mingle Event on Friday evening before the sale.
- Please note, if the scholarship recipient is a CSU student employee, any financial award may be subject to tax per Colorado State law.
